To rank in the Global 100, companies must meet criteria that include scoring well on 25 measures of sustainability, enduring financial strength and strong management teams.


Construction methodology

The Mackenzie Corporate Knights Global 100 Index Fund and ETF tracks the Corporate Knights Global 100 Index by investing in equity securities issued by companies anywhere in the world. Selected based on an evaluation of sustainability characteristics developed by Corporate Knights, companies are equally weighted and reconstituted annually to align with the new ranking. Sector allocation aligns to the MSCI All Country World Index (ACWI), while additional diversification comes from a lower concentration to North America (approximately 30% underweight) and greater exposure to small-mid caps (20% vs. less than 2% for benchmark).

- An all-in-one solution, offering investors access to the Corporate Knights' top 100 most sustainable companies in the world through the Corporate Knights' Global 100 Index.

Fund series descriptions

Series A – Bundled series that is available in front-end, redemption charge and low load purchase options.

Series PW – Investors are automatically enrolled to series PW once \$100,000 of household assets with Mackenzie mutual funds is reached

Series T5/T8 – Series that pays out an annual 5% or 8% monthly cash flow on commission based series.

Series F5/F8 – Series that pays out an annual 5% or 8% monthly cash flow on fee-based series.
